ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries must be postmarked by Friday, February 5th. Entries postmarked or received after the 5th must include a \$25.00 late fee to be accepted. **Absolutely no entries received after February 12th. No refunds on entries. Extra events added at the competition will cost \$10.00 per event.**

OPEN EVENTS: Ages: 0-6, 7-9, 10-12, 13-15, 16+. **Large divisions will be divided, and events with less than 2 contestants will be combined.** Age is determined by the age of the child on September 1, 2009.

ENTRY FEE: \$8.00 per event, **\$30.00** for Miss Twirling Athletes Age Group Pageant which includes 4 events, \$15.00 per duet, \$21.00 per trio, \$4.00 per team & corps member. **All team & corps entries must be sent in by 1 person to include name, address and birth date of each member and \$8.00 gym fee for each member who is not already entered.**
\$25.00 returned check fee.

AWARDS: Trophies for 1st, ribbons for 2nd-5th place. Age Group Miss Twirling Athlete winners will receive **CROWNS, BANNERS AND FLOWERS, 2nd & 3rd medals, 4th & 5th ribbons.** **Special High Point** awards from Star Line Baton will be awarded to the contestant accumulating the most points in the 0-9, 10-12, 13 & over division. Events must have at least two participants to count towards high point. Special awards to 1st place teams/corps.

INFORMATION: NBTA and USTA events will be offered. All modeling events will be held first followed by open events. Teams will perform last.
Special-first time to compete in the event.
Novice- has not won (3) first places or placed first in a higher division.
Beginner- has not won (5) first places or placed first in a higher division.
Intermediate- has won (5) first places, but not 8 or a higher division first.
Advanced- has won (3) novice, (5) beginner, (8) intermediate or placed 1st in advanced division.

*****Important:** One contestant constitutes a division-uncontested wins count for advancement. In addition, the contestant must enter actual status level. Challenging and double entering are only allowed in open events. A contestant may only enter a higher division to challenge if they have entered their own status division.
