Why should my child twirl?

Twirling is an effective method of teaching complex thinking skills as well as physical conditioning and musical timing.

Many kids have raised their test scores in reading and math after attending this type of a program. It also prepares your child for tryouts for the H.S. Marching Band and opportunities for college scholarships.

What age should my child start?

Like a foreign language, the younger a child is exposed to the sport of twirling the more they will achieve.

Kindergarten is a good starting time, but kids may begin at any age.

Why would my child want to learn to twirl?

Besides providing self-confidence, physical fitness, personal motivation, self-expression, mental and physical discipline, performance, travel opportunities and scholarship opportunities to attend college, it is lots of fun. Awards & trophies at end of each session.

Who teaches the program?
